Policy & Procedure Agreement

Safety & Health Guidelines:

- _____ Clean aqua socks or shoes are the only approved footwear, and are required to be worn by every client entering the pools.
- _____ Pool patrons must take a cleansing shower before entering the pool or spa.
- _____ The Peter B. Lewis Aquatic Therapy Center cannot be held responsible for the breakdown effect that chlorine may have on swimsuit fabric.
- _____ No lotions or deodorants are to be applied to body prior to using pool.
- _____ Must be independent with dressing or be accompanied by a personal caregiver.
- _____ Food, beverages, glass, gum, and tobacco products are prohibited in the pool area and locker rooms.
- _____ Swim bags and personal clothing are to be stored in the locker room.
- _____ Individuals 17 years old and under are not permitted to utilize the Aquatic Center unless referred by a physician for therapy.
- _____ Entry into the pool area is absolutely not allowed when a lifeguard is off duty.
- _____ Admission to the recreational pool will be refused to anyone appearing to have a contagious or infectious condition, such as any communicable skin disease, sore or inflamed eyes, cold, nasal or ear discharges or any other communicable disease. Please refer to policy and procedure “Contraindications to Aquatic Therapy” for complete list and instructions.
- _____ No Band-Aids or casts may be worn in the pool or spa.
- _____ Expecting, blowing the nose, or urinating in the pools is forbidden.
- _____ Users of the spa should observe posted health guidelines.
- _____ Swimmers may use approved masks, snorkels, and fins. The mask glass must be tempered and the mask must fit correctly.
- _____ Those taking photos must have a photo release.
- _____ The spa capacity is eight (8).
- _____ Limit spa use to 10-15 minutes.
- _____ Pregnant women, clients suffering from heart disease, diabetes, high or low blood pressure should not enter the spa without prior medical consultation and permission from their doctor.
- _____ Use of the spa is prohibited while under the influence of alcohol, tranquilizers, or other drugs that cause drowsiness or raise or lower blood pressure.
- _____ Soiled towels should be placed in dirty linen bins.
- _____ Patrons must bring their own lock for lockers. Do not bring valuables into the pool area.
- _____ Entry to pool hallway is locked and must be accessed by front desk personnel. Please advise receptionist of your arrival and she will buzz you in.
- _____ All jewelry must be removed before entering pools.
